Are your pets ready for the Christmas holidays

1. If you are going away, have you booked pet accommodation ? Ring ASAP. This includes pet sitters.
2. Double check you can find your pets vaccination card.... or ring us for a replacement one.
3. Ask the kennel if you can take your own food... this reduces the risk of tummy upsets.
4. If your pet is on medication.... Write down the instructions clearly for who ever is caring for your pet.
5. Don't forget to apply tick prevention before leaving your pet.

Don't let Christmas goodwill hurt your pet

We want the holiday to be a happy time for you and your pet, not a time for an emergency visit to your veterinarian. The food and decorations that make Christmas so much fun for us can be dangerous for your pet.

Avoid giving pets the following food items.

Alcohol, chocolate, coffee, ham (ham fat & ham bones), grapes and raisins, macadamia nuts, onions, spoiled uncooked meat, fish and poultry.

Other items ingested by pets at Christmas time include: Fish hooks, sinkers and line, corncobs, plastic or foil wrap, tobacco products, meat soaked strings from rump roasts are also enticing,

TICK WATCH
