

It's Tick Time

Yes, it's that time of the year again, and this year the ticks have been causing havoc earlier than normal. Last August we treated only seven animals with tick Paralysis, this year in August we treated fifteen. Given the current weather it looks like it is going to be a big tick season.

- Check pets daily
- Keep up with regular tick prevention
- If your pet is starting to become ill, seek veterinary attention soon as possible for a quicker recovery.
- Untreated pets with tick paralysis often die, so get your pet to the vet ASAP. The sooner we treat the better the prognosis.
